Biography

Quentin Guerineau began his career in 2016 in the Treasury Department as Deputy Head of the Bureau, responsible first for Housing and then for Insurance Companies and Intermediaries. In 2021, he was appointed as Advisor for Industry 4.0, Europe, Territories and Attractiveness to the Minister Delegate for Industry, then in 2022 he rejoined Executive Management of the Treasury Department as Head of the Insurance Companies and Intermediaries Bureau. In 2023, he joined the Ministry of Energy Transition as Deputy Director of the Cabinet, before becoming Director of the Cabinet to the Minister Delegate for Agriculture and Food Sovereignty in early 2024.

Since autumn 2024 and until the end of 2025, he has held the position of Director of the Cabinet to the Minister of Environmental Transition.

Quentin Guerineau is Head Engineer of Corps des Ingénieurs des Ponts, des Eaux et des Forêts (Corps of the Engineers of Bridges, Waters and Forests) and a graduate of École Polytechnique.
